P1 New Hosts Crawl

Outcomes:

- **Measurable:**

 - Completed LT1 & Signed Leader Application
- **Values:**
 - Understand and have written small group guidelines
 - Host to have a personal health plan
 - Understand and implement shared group ownership
 - Understand sub-grouping
- Once they complete P1 then uncheck P1 and check the box P2 in their “modify group” details.

Care by Community Leaders:

Train, equip and walk hosts and groups through the various outcomes. Be available to mentor and respond to issues, while keeping Group Manager Record Up-to-Date.

P2 Growing Hosts Walk

Outcomes:

 - Group Roles (Purposes)
 - Group health plan
 - Balance the five Purposes in group
- Once they complete P2 then uncheck P2 and check the box P3 in their “modify group” details.
