- 2. Ownership: Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. Psalm 139:23,24 Prov. 14:10 1 Tim5:22 Lam 3:40-42 Lam 1:18,20 Lam 5:7, 16
- 3. Release: At my first defense, no one came to my support, but everyone deserted me. May it not be held against them. But the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. - 5. Intercession: But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you Matt 5:44 Acts 8:22-24 Job 42:10 1 Sam 1:10,18
- 6. **Vengeance:** When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly. 1 Pet 2:23 Gen 50:15-19 Ro 12:17-20 1 Cor 3:15
